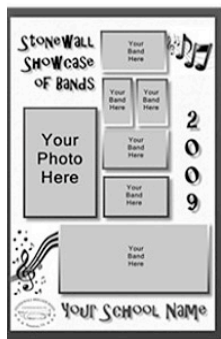

Bands perform at fifteen minute intervals, with breaks in the schedule as announced. The awards ceremony will be held approximately 15 minutes after the final performance of the day. Drum Majors, Drumline captains, Guard Captains remain in uniform and line up on the track with their directors in performance order with the first band at the lake end of the track.

Band scores are obtained by adding the Music Winds, Music Percussion, Marching, and General Effects scores and converting to a 100 point scale. There is a link to the information page on the main page of the site, near the bottom. The recap sheet will be posted by 6 pm. Videos, if available, will be posted in several days.

The Stonewall Brigade Band was formed in 1855 as the Mountain Saxhorn Band, and received its current name as General Stonewall Jackson's staff band during the Civil War. We are the nation's oldest continuous municipally sponsored community band. As an all-volunteer concert band we perform every Monday at 8 pm during the Summer in the park gazebo as well as at other concerts throughout the year. Rehearsals are Mondays from 8-9:30 pm October through May in the band room at the entrance to the park. Membership numbers about 120 players ranging in age from 14 to 86. No audition is required. To join, speak to any band member today or email the director from the link on the band web page. Today's event is co-sponsored by The Stonewall Brigade Band and the City of Staunton Department of Parks and Recreation. Your purchase at our concession stand helps fund the Stonewall Brigade Band's music budget. Concessions are by ticket. Tickets are sold at the tent for \$1 each. Prices are posted at the concession stand.
